About Him & Her Do Texas Women

Him & Her Do Texas Women is the third release of the Texas-based duo, Him & Her—Brenda Freed & Michael D'Eath (DEE-uth). This release includes 12 bluesy, jazzy, swingy tunes; one co-written by Brenda Freed and 11 by other female Texas songwriters. Adding a tasty complement to Brenda's smooth and versatile vocals is Michael D'Eath, playing expressive harmonica. Duke Davis joins on upright bass to create the Him & Her Trio, the foundation for Him & Her Do Texas Women. The trio is joined by some of Texas' best on pedal steel, lead guitar, mandolin, fiddle and dobro.

The Story

After pioneering the music therapy program at the U of IA Hospitals & Clinics & singing in cover bands for years, in 1990 **Brenda** pedaled 9,000-miles by bicycle tour from her home state of IA to TX. Her tour ended in 1991 when she stumbled upon the Kerrville Folk Festival (KFF) and launched a career as a singer songwriter in Texas. She released 4 solo albums and toured the Midwest, England & Ireland, then joined **Michael** in 2001 to form *Texas Hot Flash*, which won a 2005 **Austin Music Award**, released 3 CDs, performed throughout Central Texas, Southern California, and the Midwest where the group opened for the *Charlie Daniels Band*.

Michael moved from England to Texas as a teenager to pursue a career in high technology. Twenty years later, he picked up the harmonica and started performing with Brenda. Michael has studied chromatic and diatonic harmonica in a wide variety of styles with world class teachers and performers and is a first call session player and sideman. He also teaches harmonica privately and in groups.

In addition to being performing musicians, Brenda and Michael spend their time in other music-related endeavors. Brenda teaches Effortless Singing & Harmony Singing workshops at festivals and conferences, as well as privately via Skype and in her studio in Blanco, TX, and she has a line of Effortless Music Instruction materials. In 2003, Brenda created YAPI, the Young Artist Performance Incubator, a monthly open mic for age 18 and under in Wimberley, TX. In 2013 she moved YAPI to KFF to serve youth there. Michael uses his business development skills to serve non-profits. He was a board member and chairman of the KFF Foundation and is currently President of the Society for the Preservation and Advancement of the Harmonica (www.SPAH.org). Michael is also a recording and sound engineer at their solar-powered Moondance Studios in Albert, TX.

Him & Her is available to perform as a duo, as the Him & Her Trio or as the Him & Her Band. Him & Her combine teaching (harmonica, voice and vocal harmony) and performance for festivals or other performance/workshop situations.
